### **22/12 MINUTES**

The Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 19th June 2012 were confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

No declarations of interest were made by Members in respect of items appearing on the agenda.

## 24/12 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

# (a) Applications

Members considered the following applications for planning permission (item (vi) having been received subsequent to the despatch of the agenda), arising from which it was

that the District Council be recommended to approve the application.

(ii) S/1306/12/FL Cambridge Waste Management Park, Ely Road – Local authority depot including secure compound for vehicle parking

area and associated open storage and new office building (retrospective application)

### 25/12 ROWING LAKE

The Committee was informed by the Acting Clerk that he had not received any further information from the District Council with regard to the Rowing Lake development.

### 26/12 CAM LOCKS

The Committee was informed that there was nothing to report.

### 27/12 WATERBEACH BARRACKS

Members noted the references made to the potential redevelopment of the Barracks in the South Cambridgeshire Local Plan Issues and Options report.

### 28/12 SOUTH CAMBRIDGESHIRE LOCAL PLAN ISSUES AND OPTIONS

Members were informed that a public exhibition on the South Cambridgeshire Local Plan Issues and Options report would be held at Waterbeach Primary School on 26th July 2012 from 3.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m. The Acting Clerk also drew attention to copies of a power point presentation which the District Council had provided on the report which he had circulated by e-mail to Members.

Members acknowledged that it was essential for as many residents of Waterbeach to write to the District Council opposing the redevelopment of the Barracks if this was to be omitted from the Local Plan.

# 29/12 AMENITY AND PUBLIC PLAY EQUIPMENT

Following clarification from Councillor Bull, the Acting Clerk confirmed that he would place the order for replacement play equipment at the Recreation Ground as soon as possible.

## 30/12 PLANNING ENFORCEMENT

In the absence from the meeting of Councillor P Johnson, the Acting Clerk reported that no information was available with regard to planning enforcement action by the District Council in the Parish.

### 31/12 SOLAR PANELS

Further to Minute No. 19/12, the Acting Clerk reminded Members that at the Council meeting held earlier in the month, Members had pointed out that it had been the Council's intention to arrange for the installation of solar panels on the roof of the Tillage Hall as opposed to the New Pavilion. The Committee was informed that the company developing the solar farm at Chittering had carried out an inspection of the New Pavilion subsequent to the last meeting and had confirmed that the building would be ideal for the installation of solar panels.

Having subsequently contacted the company to ask if the panels could instead be installed at the Tillage Hall, the Acting Clerk reported that the company had indicated that the panels on the New Pavilion would generate approximately 20% more electricity than panels installed on the Tillage Hall and that, if preferred, a cable could be extended to the Tillage Hall from

the New Pavilion to enable the former to gain the benefit of the additional electricity generation.

As an alternative, the company had agreed to provide information on the possibility of the Council meeting the cost of installing panels on the New Pavilion and the likely return that could be expected. Members were informed that a further report would be submitted once the information was available.

There being no further business, the meeting was declared closed at 8.15 p.m.
