32/13 MINUTES

34/13 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

(a) Applications

Members considered the following applications for planning permission, as a result of which it was:

RESOLVED

(i) That the Parish Council recommends no objection to the following application

S/1879/13VC 76 Rosemary Road, Waterbeach, Cambridge, Cambridgeshire CB25 9NB - Variation of conditions 2 and 12 of planning application S/1051/12/FL in order to substitute previously approved drawings with amended drawings to revise the design and location of the dwelling and to reduce the size of the visibility splays

(ii) That the Parish Council recommends no objection to the following application subject to the usual comments (detailed below):

S/1986/13/RM 2 Primrose Lane, Waterbeach, Cambridge Cambridgeshire, CB25 9JZ – Reserved matters scheme (Access, Appearance, Landscaping, Layout and Scale) for the erection of a detached bungalow pursuant to outline permission S/1371/12/OL

Comments:

- i) Good materials should be used.
- ii) Noise and disturbance during operation.
- iii) Noise disturbance during building works.
- iv) Dust and debris during construction.

We also drew attention to the fact that the site is located within an area of sheltered housing and there is some concern that residents should not suffer undue disruption.

(b) Amendment

S/1516/13/FL Land at Radical Farm, Chittering Drove, Waterbeach, Cambridgeshire. Construction of 20MW solar farm and associated works.

The committee noted that the name of the application site has been amended to Palmers North Fen Farm and that access to the site, previously proposed via the A10 would now be from the North via the A1123 and on internal estate roads.
